Conditions of Entry

19 July - 4 September 2024

The competition will be judged by artist Huw Gareth Jones. There will be five categories, with prizes as follows:

Adult

1st £500 cash prize 2nd £250 cash prize 3rd £125 cash prize

^{*} For each of the Junior sections, a £150 voucher for art supplies will be given to the school attended by the child who is the 1st prize-winner in each Junior category.

Conditions of entry

- 1 Open to everyone living in the Counties of Anglesey, Gwynedd or Conwy.
- 2 Work may be in any medium (eg paint, drawing, print, collage), but photographs, 3D and sculpture are excluded.
- 3 All adult category work must be framed (canvases on stretchers with mirror plates permitted), and have mirror plates fitted ready for hanging.
- 4 Adult work may be for sale, and a commission of 25% will be deducted from sales. The price or NFS must be marked on the Entry form.
- 5 Work must be clearly marked on the back with the details as on the Entry form.
- 6 A handling fee is to be paid, as follows: Adult: £5 for the first entry, and £2.50 for each subsequent entry. Junior A, B, C, and D: Free one entry per child. Subsequent entries £1 each. Cash only, no cheques.
- 7 Age for the purpose of the Junior categories is to be that on 1 May 2024.
- 8 Those who would normally be in the Junior A category may elect instead to enter their work in the Adult section, and should mark their Entry form accordingly, adult fees being applicable.
- 9 In the event that entries exceed the hanging space available, a hanging committee will decide those works to be hung.
- 10 No entry fees can be returned.
- 11 Work is to be brought to the Ucheldre Centre from **Thursday 11** to **Saturday 13 July** between 10 am & 5 pm. Please contact the Centre if this creates any problems. Entry forms, with fees, must be handed into the Ucheldre Centre with the work.
- 12 All work must be available for exhibition in the Centre from 19 July 4 September. All works sold are to be left in the Exhibition until 4 September 2023.
- 13 Work is to be collected from the Centre between 5-7 September 2024. If work has not been collected by 30 September 2024, the Centre reserves the right to dispose of these works for its own benefit.
- 14 Prizewinners will be announced at the opening of the Exhibition on Thursday 18 July at 4pm, to which all competitors are invited. The Exhibition opens to the public at 10am on 19 July 2024.
- 15 The judge's decision is final, and correspondence cannot be entered into.
